Re: Year 10 GCSE Science ISA

Your child is currently completing end of Year 10 examinations and you will receive a full report before the end of this term.

Your child will take a GCSE in Core Science and a GCSE in Additional Science in 2017. Some pupils will take a GCSE in Further Science. All pupils must complete an ISA (practical assessment) for each of these GCSE Science exams.
