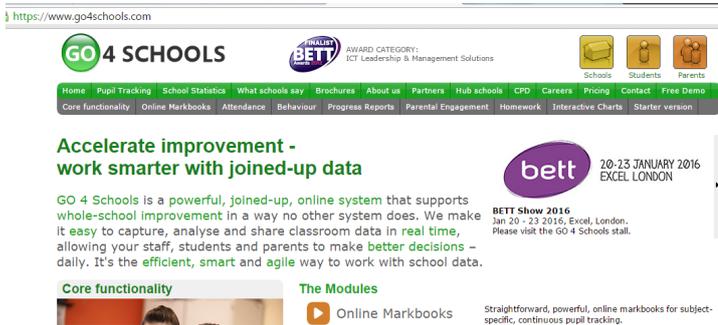

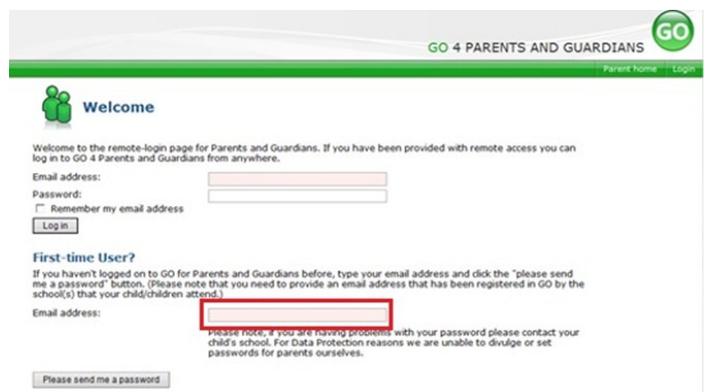
To access the site, go to www.go4schools.com.

Progress Reports – Full written reports which are published once a year

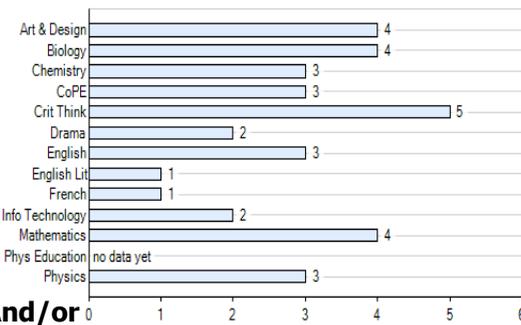
Behaviour information – Postive and negative behaviour events

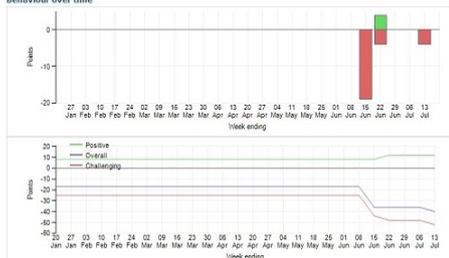

Timetable:

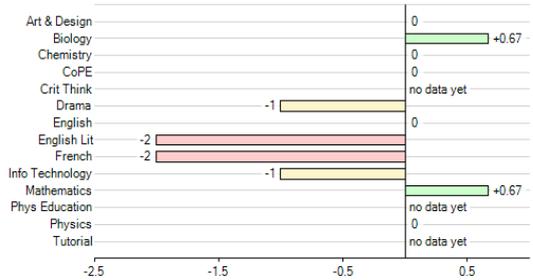
You will be able to see your child's full timetable.
