SECTION 48 INSPECTION

The school works closely with the Diocese of Westminster. One role of the Diocese is to inspect its schools to evaluate their Catholic life and their Catholic curriculum provision. Usually this is every four years. Our last inspection was in 2011.

The Diocese Inspection will take place on Thursday and Friday 13th and 14th October 2016. It will be led by Fr Antony Homer who is also keen to meet parents. If you are able to do so also, you are warmly invited to our usual Parents Forum on Friday 14th October 2016 at 9am.

The inspection report will be shared with parents when received.

You will be aware that we recently carried out a parental questionnaire on Catholic Life. The results were very positive and are detailed below. In particular, it was pleasing to see that so many of the parents who responded said that the school offers a distinctively Catholic Education and clear moral teaching.

I have already addressed some aspects of feedback where there were areas for development, for example where some parents wanted further information on the RE curriculum. I will be working with the leadership team to address other areas for development.
