Year 11 Examinations

From the **23rd February 2015** until the **4th March 2015**, Year 11 students will undertake a course of pre public exams. These exams are designed to give students a final chance to prepare before the real examinations begin in May. The information gained by your child's teacher is also invaluable in helping to determine which students need extra support before the final exams.

Parents will receive a full written report in the week beginning the **23rd March 2015**. Please be supportive of your child at what is an incredibly stressful stage of their life and please remind them of the necessity of Saturday school and after school tuition.
