Results at the school this year have continued to rise for the fourth year in a row, against national trends, with 84% A\*-C grades. In addition, 85% secured A\*-C grades in RE, 77% secured A\*-C grades in Maths, 74% in Core Science, 63% in English and 91% in French, just to mention a few of our successes. All of these achievements are above national results. Our A Level results continue to be graded as outstanding.

These excellent results are secured through the dedication of our staff, the hard work of the students and your support.

The school is continuing this work this year, providing both after-school and Saturday revision sessions to help your child prepare for GCSE 2015.
