BEHAVIOUR OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL

In our recent inspection, the school was described as outstanding. At the Hackney Music Gala last week the talents of our students shone through as did the applications by a record number of our Sixth Form to Oxford and Cambridge. These are just a few examples of reasons to feel very proud of our school.

Unfortunately, a small number of students let the school and themselves down by the way that they behave when they leave school. I ask that you remind your child that they:

- should not loiter after school in the local area
- should not visit fast food shops whilst wearing their school uniform and the Sixth Form should not bring fast food on to school site
- behaviour on public transport and in the streets should reflect the same high standards expected whilst in school

The consequences of such behaviour as described in the above will be a range of serious sanctions, including Headteacher detentions and/or being kept behind and escorted off the premises later than the rest of the school.

As the nights draw in, it is even more important that your child makes their way directly home.
