SPORTS DAY TRAVEL - WEDNESDAY 5TH JULY 2017

The school sports day takes place this year at Mile End Stadium on Wednesday 5th July 2017. The events begin at 10am and end at 3pm. The travel arrangements to the stadium are as follows:

Year 7 will arrive at school at 7.45am promptly. They will be registered in the lunch hall and make their way to the venue by coach. They will also be taken back to school at the end of the day by coach and dismissed from here. If parents/carers are happy for their child to leave from the stadium. They will have the choice to do so but **must** have submitted the permission slip overleaf.

Year 8 will arrive at school at 7.45am promptly. They will be registered in the assembly hall and make their way to the venue by bus. They will also be taken back to school at the end of the day by bus and dismissed from here. All groups will be escorted by the appropriate number of adults both on journey to and from the venue. Students are expected to have their Oyster cards with them.

Year 9 will arrive at school at 7.45am promptly. They will be registered in the Sports Hall and make their way to the venue by bus. They will also be taken back to school at the end of the day by bus and dismissed from here. All groups will be escorted by the appropriate number of adults both on journey to and from the venue. Students are expected to have their Oyster cards with them.



Instructions on how to reach the venue are provided overleaf. Staff from the school will supervise the bus stops and the relevant crossings near the stadium. <u>Travel to the venue by Bus</u> Two bus routes are available and include:

277 from Terrance Road T Bus stop. This journey takes approximately 29 minutes and students should leave home with enough time to avoid being late as the journey will take place toward the end of rush hour.

425 from Morning Lane Bus stop outside school. This journey takes approximately 29 minutes and students should leave home with enough time to avoid being late as the journey will take place toward the end of rush hour. Students arriving on the 425 should alight at Mile end where staff will supervise their crossing and arrival at the stadium.

Travel by Car

Car journeys from Hackney should take 20 minutes although please allow for rush hour traffic.
