**YEAR 10 VISIT TO THE WORLD WAR ONE BATTLEFIELDS IN FRANCE**

<b>Venue:</b>	Le Chateau d'Ebblinghem, World War One Battlefields, France
<b>Date(s):</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> - June 2018 – 4 <sup>th</sup> June 2018
<b>Time:</b>	Leaving at 4am on the 1 <sup>st</sup> June 2018.
<b>Travel arrangements:</b>	Students will travel by private coach from Cardinal Pole to Dover, on the ferry to France and then by private coach in France and Belgium.
<b>Cost:</b>	£295
<b>Meals:</b>	All meals will be included for the four dates with the exception of a packed lunch on the first day of travel, which the student will need to supply.

Documents required

Thank you for all of the parents who are up to date with payments and have already provided the travel documents needed by your child. At this point students should have:

- Paid £100 on the total
- Handed in their European Health Insurance Card to Ms Holmes
- Handed in a copy of the photo page of their passport to Ms Holmes

Next payment

There are two final payments outstanding, although students can pay the remaining balance at any time. The next payments are due:

**Payment Three: £95 due 26<sup>th</sup> March 2018**
