TRIP TO DEBATE COMPETITION: FOREIGN & COMMONWEALTH OFFICE IN CENTRAL LONDON

Your child has been selected to attend an after-school debate competition designed for sixth-formers, at a prestigious central London venue. The trip will take place after school (pupils will miss period 7 only) and will involve a guided tour of the ministry building at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office.
