MORE ABLE SUMMER CHALLENGE

I am writing to inform you about our Summer Challenge for those students who are more academically able. Currently your child is on our register as one of those students.

Cardinal Pole Catholic School is committed to helping your child achieve their full potential and we would like your support in encouraging your child to take up our summer challenge. They will have been given a booklet containing information about culturally enriching things to see and do over the summer holidays.
