School Closure and Planned Curriculum Changes

I hope you enjoyed the half term and are currently enjoying the sunshine. The school remained open during the half term break with an extensive revision programme for our children preparing for exams and I trust that this was of value to them.

The school has planned a number of changes to the curriculum in response to identified priorities, government policy and approaches to teaching and learning. This has required a great deal of preparation by staff at the school and has also required changes to the timing of the school day. The change to the school day includes the introduction of six lessons per day, replacing the five held currently. Details are included below. Changes to curriculum content will be shared with you through curriculum evenings and a curriculum booklet prepared for each child. These changes will support the school in becoming outstanding.

Registration will now take place at the end of each school day at 3pm, with the formal end of the school day at 3.10pm, bringing an end to the early close on Friday.
