Year 10 GCSE Science Trip to Hunterian Museum London - Friday 27th June 2014

The Science Department have arranged for pupils in class 10P1 to visit the Hunterian Museum at Royal College of Surgeons on Friday 27th June 2014.

The Hunterian Museum collections have been brought together over four centuries by a cast of colourful characters including the surgeon and anatomist John Hunter (1728-1793).

They are a fascinating mix of human and animal anatomy and pathology specimens, wax teaching models, surgical and dental instruments as well as paintings, drawings and sculpture. Permanent displays and a changing programme of temporary exhibitions encourage visitors to explore the science and art of surgery.

Our pupils will attend a guided tour around the museum run by a retired surgeon and will be given some time to explore the collections themselves. This is an enriching opportunity for them to deepen their knowledge and understanding of anatomy and physiology broadly covered in B3 Biology Unit of the National Curriculum they are studying at the moment.

We will be departing from school at 9:00am. We ask all pupils to be at the reception by 8:55am straight after they are registered in their form groups.

We will be travelling by public transport – bus 55 and pupils will need to bring their Oyster cards with them on the day.

Refreshments will be available to purchase at the museum's café, but if pupils wish to bring their own packed lunches, they are welcome to. Pupils on free school meals will be provided with lunch.

We will be leaving the Museum at around 2pm, returning to school for 3pm.
