Year 11 Half-Term Revision

I am writing to you to let you know that GCSE courses in Maths, Geography and English will take place at the School during the October half-term holiday. Ms Gallagher will advise your son/daughter if they have been invited to English provision. Further details are attached.

This is an excellent opportunity for your child to prepare for their 2014 GCSE Public examinations. Your son/daughter must achieve a minimum of a C grade in both English and in Mathematics to secure a range of opportunities post GCSE.
