**Year 7 Assessment 4 Report**

The report shows the level your child is currently working at and their end of Key Stage 3 targets.

The expected level of progress over the Key Stage is two levels – so if your child joined the school on a Level 4, they would be expected to progress at the end of year 9 to a Level 6. If your child joined the school on a Level 5, they would be expected to progress to a Level 7. Each level is divided into 3 sublevels e.g. 5a is a good level 5, 5b is an average level 5, 5c is a weak level 5.

We now ask if you could support your child by discussing the enclosed report and monitoring their progress, especially work at home. Students should pay close attention to the academic advice in this report and continue to work hard in the coming academic year so they can reach their potential and be successful.
