

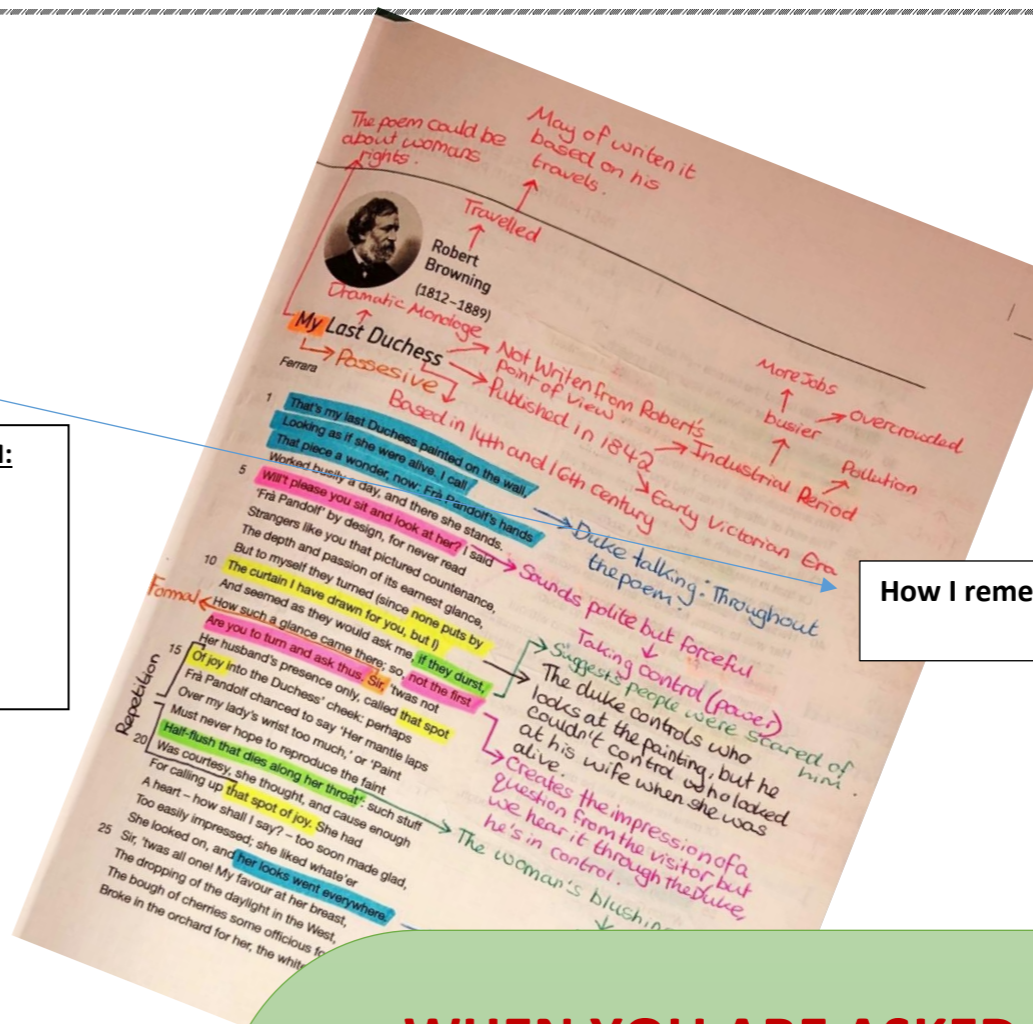

How I remember the word

**EXAMPLES:**  
Surprisingly, my critical professor returned the rough draft of my essay without a single annotation.  
The editor will leave an annotation or comment near every correction she makes in the manuscript

## WHEN YOU ARE ASKED TO ANNOTATE:

- Analyse the title.
- Number the paragraphs.
- Chunk the text.
- Read the text line by line.
- Underline, circle, and comment with a purpose; underline figurative language, circle tone words, and box motifs.
- Left margin: what is the author saying? ( ...
- Right margin: what is the author doing? (
