

The Hajj



This is the Mina stampede. Where all the Pilgrims head to Mina where they stay an entire day carrying out all the rituals of Hajj and prayers.



After sunset, pilgrims head to Muzadalifah to observe the Asr and Maghrib prayers and rest till night until Fajr prayers in preparation for the next day's ritual of stoning the devil.



Halq and Taqsir is where men get their hair completely shaved or clipped whilst women are forbidden to shave their heads and only allowed to have a lock or strand of their hair clipped. The act of cutting the hair symbolizes one's detachment from physical appearances and complete submission to Allah.

I chose this one because I wanted to learn more about the Islam faith.

My favourite feature is the Halq and Taqsir because it shows how strong their belief is and how committed they are to getting closer to Allah.



During the second day of Hajj, the pilgrims travel to Arafat from Mina reciting Tasbeeh of Labbaik Allahumma Labbaik.



On the 11th and 12th days of Hajj, pilgrims must complete the stoning of the devil. This is where they throw seven pebbles at the stone structure.
