## YEAR 7 INDUCTION WEEK: MONDAY 7<sup>TH</sup> – FRIDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2020

I am pleased to confirm dates and details of the September induction plans for Year 7. The current guidance from the Government states that students should be kept in 'year group' bubbles. Year 7 will not mix with any other year groups for this reason and will be isolated on the first floor for all activities and lessons until further notice.

Where: Cardinal Pole Catholic School, 205 Morning Lane, E9 6LG
When: 8:30am – 3pm; Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2020
Uniform: Students should wear full school uniform.
What to bring: Pencil case, one piece of English and Maths work from primary school, packed lunch if not on Free School Meals (no fizzy drinks – juice or water only).

The return of the other year groups will be staggered to ensure that your child is safe and that all students understand how the school is operating in their whole year group bubbles. This means that we are working very differently as a school as each year group will be located in specific base rooms. Logistically, this is a challenge for schools and I am grateful for your forbearance whilst we continue to provide an engaging and challenging education and experience in a safe and welcoming environment.

As part of the induction arrangements students will meet key staff, take part in a range of fun activities designed to get to know one another and complete some routine testing. The induction days are designed to be a welcoming and informative introduction to the school and will take place while most of the other year groups are off-site, providing the perfect opportunity for your child to explore and familiarise themselves with the building.

As part of our Year 6 into 7 transition curriculum project we ask that they each student brings with them a photocopy of their both best piece of English and Maths work from this year. We hope it will give us a deeper understanding of your child's abilities and interests, while allowing us to share in something that they are proud of.

## It is very important that your child attends the induction days. If your child cannot attend for any reason please call to let the office know.



Please accompany your child to school on the day and sign them on arrival. You will be required to state whether they will be collected again at 3pm or if they will be allowed to make their own way home.

We look forward to welcoming your child in September where we will begin a productive and positive relationship, working together to achieve the best for your child both in their academic and future wellbeing.
