Canteen going well, the new water machines were installed over half term, this is for flavoured water and can be filled using a token as part of their meal deal. This is sugar free water and is included for £2.25. Priority lunch in the morning for Years 10 & 11 continues and the rest of school have lunch at lunchtime, Years 10 & 11 can each at lunchtime if they prefer to. Food uptake higher than previously, but still room for further refinement. Strict DFE guidelines on food additives on salt, spice and sugar etc. so they are restricted slightly with requests. Student Council want to change some things i.e. removing pasta. A fixed feedback station using a tablet will be installed shortly where they can input real time feedback.

We have lots of companies and workshops coming into school at present working with our students. Thanks to Jonathan Howard, Careers Guidance Manager for his assistance on providing proforma letters and company lists.
