Dear Parents/Carers,

YEAR 10 LIVE LESSONS

I hope this letter finds you well at this difficult time.

I am writing to inform you that starting on Monday 18th January, we will be offering 17 periods a week live teaching for all Year 10 students. This will cover every subject and will follow the timings of your child's usual school timetable. The remaining lessons that are not taught live should be used for the completion of work set, revision and independent study.

For clarity:

- Lessons are compulsory and your child is expected to attend as per the enclosed timetable.
- Students should log into the lessons on or just before the start of lesson. Attendance and punctuality will be closely monitored.
- Behaviour expectations are exactly the same as they would be in school. Poor behaviour online will not be tolerated.
- Students are to complete all work set in their Live Lessons.
- Students who do not engage with Live Lessons are likely to be asked to return to school to work onsite.
