RETURN TO STUDENTS ON SITE

We are excited at the news recently announced that all children can return to school. Although we have had a high number of vulnerable children and the children of key workers on site throughout this time, I am delighted that we are now planning for all children to return to site.

I will write shortly in more detail about the time slot at which your child should attend school on their designated day.

Please note that your child does not need to attend school in uniform for the testing, but must wear a face mask.

The timescale is as follows:

Monday 8 th March	Staff, children of Keyworkers and vulnerable	Years 11/12/13 & Keyworker/Vulnerable from 11am	No lessons – students should see work on SMH
Tuesday 9 th March	Year 10	Years 11/12/13 & Keyworker/Vulnerable	Years 7,8 and 9
Wednesday 10 th March	Year 9 and 8	Years 11/12/13 & Keyworker/Vulnerable	Years 7 and 10
Thursday 11 th March	Catch-up tests and staff re-testing	Years 10/11/12/13 & Keyworker/Vulnerable	Years 7, 8 and 9
Friday 12 th March	Year 7	Years 7/10/11/12/13 & Keyworker/Vulnerable	Years 8 and 9
Monday 15 th March	Years 8 & 9	All students	No remote teaching unless student shielding
