## **ASSESSMENT POINT 2 WEEK: 14<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> June 2021 (Year 8)**

From Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2021, all students will be following a bespoke timetable for their Assessment Point 2. The school day will start at the usual time of 8.35am with students expected to arrive at 8.30am. Rather than attending lessons, the day is then divided into three 1.5 hour slots during which students will either complete exams or participate in Music/Drama/PE lessons, which are being assessed holistically rather than by a written exam. The final session finishes at 2.45pm and students will be dismissed from their final exam of the day at this time.
