The AP2 exams will go on all week and then dedicated time is given over to the students after the papers are marked to review and discuss their subject papers/results.

Culture week/sports day will commence towards the end of the year, the curriculum is suspended and as a way of celebrating the students' achievements, there are a range of trips/visits organised, details of which are being planned at present.
