Dear Parent/Carer

YEAR 12 AND 13 RETURN TO ON SITE EDUCATION 8^{TH} MARCH 2021 AND COVID TESTING THURSDAY 4^{TH} MARCH 2021

In line with the Government announcement on the return to school on 8th March and to ensure your child can return to school, Year 12 and 13 students are invited in on **Thursday 4th March** to complete lateral flow COVID-19 testing. Our test centre is run by trained staff and has been vetted by Public Health England. The lateral flow tests will help the school to ensure that we minimise the risk from COVID -19.

Students need to remain socially distanced from each other on the way into and on the school site to avoid those who may test positive coming in contact with each other and so their entrance and exit has been staggered

Students will arrive through reception where they will be registered and taken to the canteen. They should arrive 15 minutes before their test time. After the test is complete they will be dismissed from the School site. Only those who test positive in the test will be contacted by the school.

Students are not required to wear uniform. After testing your child should make their way straight home and they are not to delay their return home by vising the local shops or socialising with others.

There will be no Live MS Teams lessons on Thursday 4th March for Sixth Form students. Your child should use this time to prepare for the return to school.

You must ensure that you have completed Lateral Flow Test agreement online so that testing can take place.

Sixth Form students should arrive through the school reception from 10.30 am for registration followed by timetabled lessons
