YEAR 13 MOCK EXAMINATIONS

I am writing to inform you that the Year 13 mock examinations will take place between Monday 5th November and Tuesday 13th November 2018. The mock examination timetable is on the other side of this page. During this time students will be required to be in school at least 30 minutes before the start of each of their exams. Latecomers will not be admitted in line with public examination practice. When A-Level students do not have exams they will be able to study at home. Students may come into school to study in the Sixth Form area or library during this period if they wish.

It is imperative that students use the half-term period to prepare for these exams. Content covered will include both work from Year 12 and 13 so a good amount of revision is necessary. Please encourage your child to use the entire half term period to work hard at consolidating content covered thus far.

A-Level students will be back in school on Wednesday 14th November 2018 to resume normal lessons.
