YEAR 8 COVID TESTING MARCH 10TH AND START TIME ON THE 15TH NOTIFICATION

In line with the Government announcement on the return to school and to ensure your child can return to school, Year 8 students will be invited in on Wednesday 10th March to complete lateral flow COVID-19 testing. Our test centre is run by trained staff and has been vetted by Public Health England. The lateral flow tests will help the school to ensure that we minimise the risk from COVID-19. Daily email reminders via Evolve will be sent to those who have not completed their online consent.

Students need to remain socially distanced from each other on the way into and on the school site to avoid those who may test positive coming into contact with each other and so their entrance and exit times have been staggered.

Students will arrive through the Ponsford Street entrance where they will be registered and taken to the canteen. They should arrive 15 minutes before their test time. After the test is complete they will be dismissed from the school site. Only those students who test positive will be contacted by the school.
