Dear Parents/Carers,

YEAR 10 – WIDER OPENING OF SCHOOLS

You will have heard in the press and Government announcements about the return to school for some year groups. Your child is in Year 10 and you will have been surveyed for your views on your child returning to school, I am reflecting carefully on your comments and subject to risk assessments, the school is considering a phased return for Year 10. This will enable the students to have a chance to familiarise themselves with the new working arrangements and health and safety.

These arrangements will include social distancing, hygiene procedures, no food on site only water, no equipment to be brought in from home by the students – i.e. pencil cases and exercise books will be provided and kept in school. There will be a subject specialist briefing to students over two days. In advance of this, for those students whose parents/carers have agreed for their child to attend school, they will need to attend a Health & Safety briefing. A separate letter will be sent to you with further details of dates and times shortly.

We have also reflected on your comments about face-to-face teaching and are looking to upload pre-recorded lessons by staff at the school shortly. In the interim, staff will continue to upload work onto Show My Homework and we will be sending out CGP booklets for your child. This is in anticipation of Year 10 mocks taking place at the end of June.
