**PHASED RETURN TO SCHOOL FOR YEARS 10 & 12
VIRTUAL SCHOOL CONTINUES FOR YEARS 7-10**

I hope you are all well! You should by now have collected the resources for your child from the school to support their learning. The postage cost of £7.00 per child makes postal services both expensive and at the same time unreliable.

Year 12 parents/carers will by now have received a timetable about their child's return to school from Monday 15th detailing the arrangements and expectations. Year 10 will shortly receive a timetable of their return for two days during the period from Wednesday 17th – Wednesday 24th June. The purpose of both these year groups attending school is to prepare for their mock exams. Years 7-9 will receive separate notification of their arrangements.

Alongside this, I would like to remind you that it is now a legal requirement for everyone travelling on public transport, to wear a face mask. If your child(ren) are going to using public transport to get to school, can I ask that you provide them with the appropriate mask for their protection. Once in school, it will for you and your child to decide on whether they continue to wear the mask whilst in school.

In preparation for September, a reminder that school uniform can be purchased online at www.roughcutscasuals.co.uk instead of attending the actual shop. A click and collect service is also being offered by the shop. However, if you still wish to visit the shop, please contact them as they do have social distancing and PPE restrictions in place which also includes children not being able to try clothes on.
