From Monday 6th December, all A-level students will be following a bespoke timetable for their Christmas Assessments. When Y12 students are not in exams, they are on study leave which can be completed in school or at home. When they do have exams, they are expected to be in school 30 minutes before their exam is due to start and will be dismissed at the end of their exams. Year 12 CTEC students will continue in lessons for this week (from Tuesday for Year 12 Health and Social care, who have their exam on Monday 6th December).
