All students will now receive two 30 minute breaks in the school day. Years 10 & 11 will be offered a priority lunch at break time, this is particularly useful as we head towards examination season when many students choose to use their lunchtime for additional study. If students in Years 10 & 11 wish to eat in the lunch time slot, they are welcome to, but they will need to queue with the other year groups. Sixth Form students are free to have their lunch at either break or lunchtime.

Apart from Year 7 who will be attending school as normal for Lateral Flow Testing on Thursday 6th January 2021, the rest of the school will have a late start school in order to give families a chance to attend Mass together in their Parish for the Feast of Epiphany, students should go to form for registration at 11am, moving to their period 3 lesson afterwards.
