RE: YEAR 11 SIXTH FORM APPLICATIONS

I am writing to clarify the process for Year 11 students applying to our Sixth Form.

Year 11 students can apply to join the Sixth Form by filling in a short application form. This can be found on our website or by following this link: [Application Form](#). We have extended the deadline for internal student applications to Thursday 26th January 2023.

In this form students will have the opportunity to select the subjects they wish to study. This can be either three or four A-Levels, or one vocational CTEC course. These decisions are not final and will be discussed with students at interview, and then revisited during enrolment on GCSE results day.

Following the online application, students will be invited to interview in school on Monday 30th January 2023 from 3:15pm onwards.

Following these interviews, we will make decisions about offers. These decisions will be based on a number of factors, including attendance, punctuality, work ethic and conduct, in addition to interview performance.

Students who are offered a place will either receive a firm offer or a provisional offer. Provisional offers will require students to demonstrate improved standards for the remainder of Year 11 in order to convert their provisional offer to a firm offer.

We have very high standards in the Sixth Form, and unfortunately some Year 11 students may not be offered a place. However, the school careers team will support all our students to find appropriate post-16 destinations.
