After the presentations there will be an opportunity to ask any questions you may have during our meet and greet with the Senior Leadership Team and current students, in which food and drink will be provided. This event is for both you and your child to attend. Your child will take part in a short ‘Getting to Know You’ session with other Year 7 students. We are very excited to meet you. Your child will be in Group «Group». Please be aware of this upon arrival.

#### **New Intake 1 To 1 Interviews – Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2024**

These meetings will take place with a member of the Senior Leadership Team. This event is for both you and your child to attend so that we can learn more about your child and how best to support your child through this transition from primary to secondary education.

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## **Primary Visits – May and June**

We aim to visit every primary school for an informal discussion with your child. On the day, we will also meet with their Year 6 class teacher and a representative from the school's pastoral team so that key teaching & learning and pastoral information can be shared with us.
