<u>Catering</u>

I am writing to inform parents/carers that from Ist January 2025, the cost of a school meal will be increased to £3.00 per day. Prices have remained at their current level since April 2023 but due to the increased cost of food prices, unfortunately we are unable to keep it at this rate any longer. ParentPay will continue to be the system we use to top up meal accounts and I remind parents/carers to ensure that their child's account is topped up before we return to school after half term.

Uniform
