YEAR 11 & 13 MOCK EXAMINATIONS

I am pleased to see the return of students on-site and how well they have settled as they prepare for their upcoming mock exams.

Following my letter to you on 5th February 2021, where I provided you with details of these exams, I write to provide you with additional information regarding further arrangements.

- **Year 13** students will be revising independently from Monday 22nd March to Friday 26th March and should only attend school on their exam days. Students are expected to revise at home when not in exams on their planned schedule.
- From Monday 22nd March, **Year 11** students who do not have afternoon exams will be dismissed after their morning exam and they are expected to use the time at home for revision.
- **Year 11** students are expected to arrive to school via the Ponsford Street entrance at 8.30am for a prompt 8.45am start

Students have been given their individualised exam timetables, and they should take note of their seat number for each exam. They are reminded to bring the correct equipment to their exams, including at least **two** black ink pens, a Maths set, a ruler and a scientific calculator. Mobile phones are not allowed in school and should be kept at home.

Please be aware that their mocks form the basis of part of the evidence for the production of Centre Assessed Grades.
