## CHANGE TO SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS : MONDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> & TUESDAY 19<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2022

As a result of the Government calling a National Emergency on Monday and Tuesday, due to the extreme temperature conditions expected (in excess of 40°C), we have made the decision for all students in Years 7-9 to have remote learning sessions on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July from 10am-3pm. Work will be uploaded onto Show My Homework for completion and submission by students.

Year 10 will still have their planned Work Experience workshops in school with dismissal taking place at 12.45pm and the Year 12 Progression Week will still take place as previously advised.
