Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you regarding the next scheduled Industrial Action which will now consist of two days on **Wednesday 15th** and **Thursday 16th March 2023.**

As Headteacher, I must determine the number of striking staff members on each of these days to ensure that the effective and safe provision of education continues to be achieved. Cardinal Pole will be open <u>only</u> for the groups of students detailed below.

Please see the arrangements for the different days listed below:

Wednesday 15th March 2023: Year 11 and Year 13 Students only

- Year II students should arrive to school at **9am** for registration in the canteen. They will be attending Learning Performance Revision Workshops. They will be dismissed at 2.30pm;
- Year II students studying PE and Food will be completing coursework onsite with their teachers;
- Year 13 students should arrive as normal at 8:30am and will be dismissed at 3pm. There will also be additional provision onsite for Year 13 students;
- Students classed as vulnerable should arrive as normal at 8:30am;
- Students in Years 7-10 and Year 12 will study from home on this day.

Thursday 16th March 2023: Year 10 and Year 13 Students (+ selected Year 11 Students)

- Year 10 students should arrive to school at 9am for registration in the canteen. They will be attending Learning Performance Revision Workshops. They will be dismissed at 2.30pm;
- Year 13 students should arrive as normal at 8.30am and will be dismissed at 3pm;
- Students classed as vulnerable should arrive as normal at 8.30am;
- Year II students expected in school on this day will be contacted separately if they are required to attend;
- Students in Years 7-9, 11 & 12 will study from home on this day.

We are working closely with our staff union representatives and Hackney Education to keep up to date with the situation, and I will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.

I appreciate that this will create some disruption for parents, and **I thank you once again** for your continued support of Cardinal Pole and your child's education in partnership with us. It is important to say that individual schools will be affected in different ways by this industrial action, and not every school will be able to offer the same level of provision across the borough.
