### FOCUS GROUPS: STUDENT EXPERIENCE

We are very proud of the work we do as a school around wellbeing and mental health. Wellbeing is a key school priority - alongside student surveys, training, education and parent workshops, we are focused on identifying and supporting the needs of our community.

Over the course of this half term, students will be selected at random to take part in small focus group surveys. The key focus in this set of surveys will be on students' experience of school. We will be asking a range of questions to continuously inform our whole school development priorities. Alongside giving us a valuable insight into students' experience of school, these surveys also allow us to test students' understanding of the various ways they can keep themselves safe, both inside and outside of school.
