CARDINAL POLE SPORTS DAY YEAR 7-8 MONDAY 13TH JULY 2026 AT MABLEY GREEN ASTROTURF PITCHES

The Cardinal Pole Sports Day takes place this year on Monday 13th July beginning at 8.30am and ending approximately at 2.30pm. Please ensure that your child has a water bottle so they can re-hydrate throughout the day as well as providing them with sun cream and appropriate clothing for the weather on the day. This is considered a regular day at school so any non-attendance without parental notification will be regarded as truancy.

Year 7 – 8 students will need to arrive at school no later than 9am – school gates will not open until 8.30am.

Students will line up in their year groups and be registered on the playground, they will then be supervised walking down to Mabley Green, the activities are expected to start at 9.45am and the day will end at around 2pm. The students will have a range of activities to choose from throughout the day, sun cream will be available and there will be plenty of opportunities to refill their water bottles.

Kit

Students must wear correct school PE kit, which consists of either their black tracksuit top, black Cardinal Pole polo, black shorts, black socks and suitable footwear. **(No metal studs/spikes)**. No football shirts or Crocs are permitted – appropriate footwear only. Please limit your child to one bag/holdall. The weather is expected to be very hot so please bring an umbrella to shelter from the sun.

Water/Food

Students should bring a suitable packed lunch, snacks and plenty of drinking water. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they will be provided with a school packed lunch.

Dismissal

All pupils will be escorted back to school by staff, returning at approximately 2.30pm for dismissal from outside of the school building. Pupils must return to school with their teachers and be registered before they can be dismissed.
