YEAR 7 TRANSITION DAY: THURSDAY 6th JULY 2023

The Summer term is a very busy and exciting term in all schools, particularly when considering the transition between Primary and Secondary school. To lessen students' fears and to help develop a secure relationship with our students early on we will be hosting a Transition Day as outlined below:

Where: Cardinal Pole Catholic School, 205 Morning Lane, E9 6LG. Entrance is through the main reception.

When: 8:15am – 2.45pm; Thursday 6th July 2023.

Uniform: Students should wear their usual school uniform from their primary school.

What to bring: Pencil case, if students do not have one they simply need a pen for writing

As part of the day students will meet their new Form Tutors, take part in a range of fun activities designed to get to know one another and complete some routine testing.

The day is designed to be a welcoming and informative introduction to the school and will take place while all other year groups are off-site, providing the perfect opportunity for your child to explore and familiarise themselves with the building. Please see the programme attached.

It is very important that your child attends the Transition Day. If they fail to attend they will begin the year in September less prepared than the other students and miss the opportunity to make new friends as well as getting to know staff. If your child cannot attend the day for any reason please call to let the office know.

Please accompany your child to school on the day to the school's main entrance where you will be registered. You will be required to state whether they will be collected again at 2.45pm or if they will be allowed to make their own way home. Students will be provided with some refreshments at break time and the school will provide lunch on this day.
