This is a remarkable achievement and continues our outstanding progress and outcome measures over a number of years. Staff and students are to be congratulated on this achievement and I am grateful to you, as parents/carers, for the support that you offer the school and your child in this shared endeavour. Such strong results have a strong impact on the future choices for your child and they complement the already shared success at GCSE.
