## 16-19 Additional Funding

In addition to the central PPG funding, the school also secured and additional £3,000 funding for 16-19 students to support small group tuition targeted at students who were studying a vocational Business course and were identified as PPG students. These students were supported academically thought small group and individual tuition by an experienced teacher to secure the effective completion of their course. The impact of this work was that all (4) identified students secured their Level 3 course enabling them to successfully meet target grades and their university offers.
